Organising a Street Party – 5 things you need to know

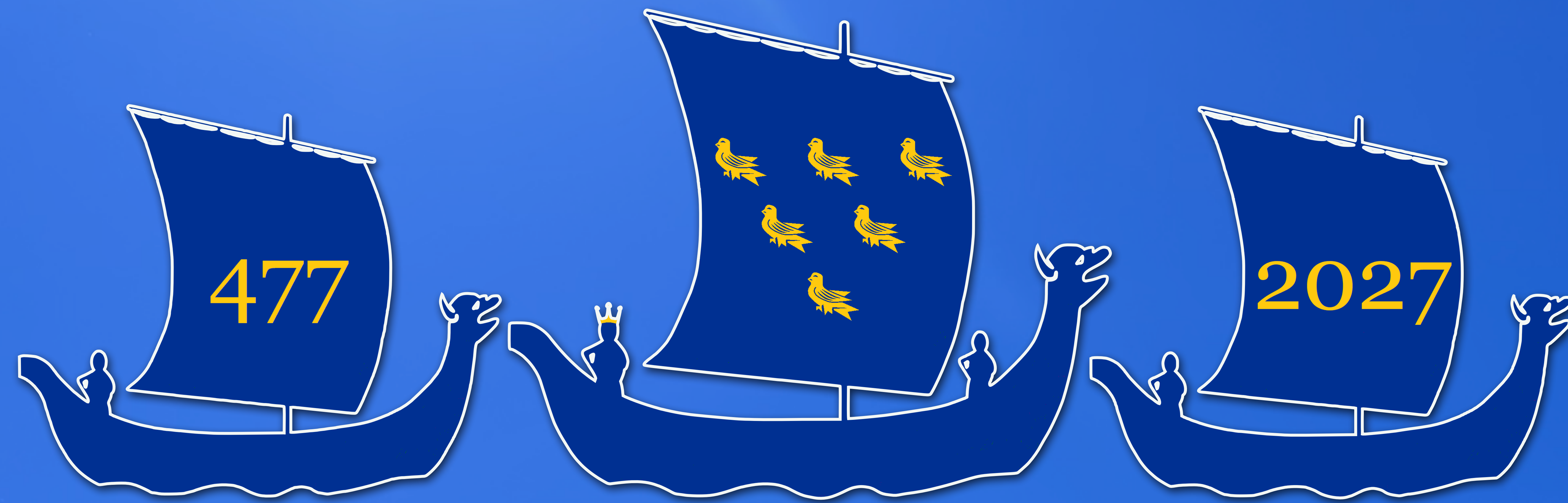
1. Get your street on board first. Talk to neighbours before contacting the council.
2. Contact your council early. Most Sussex councils need 8 to 12 weeks' notice.
3. Apply for the road closure through your district or borough council.
4. Sort insurance and safety basics if your event needs them.
5. Notify your street officially, in writing, before the day.

Fly the official County Flag of during the week of Sussex Day, inclusive of the weekends either side – Saturday 12th until Sunday 20th June 2027.
